



FACE Income Qualification

In order to better align FACE’s mission statement with our overall granting strategy, we are streamlining our income qualification process by basis applicant qualification on two factors, annual household income and household size. The below ranges are based on the U.S. Department Housing and Urban Development (HUD) income thresholds specific to Alameda and Contra Costa counties. This is consistent with other tuition assistance programs, such as BASIC, which also use HUD’s ranges to determine their income limits.

We propose using the below Low-Income Qualification income limits for FACE because this would allow us to serve a wide range of low-income applicants while keeping our granting in line with our mission.

FACE Mission Statement

- To provide tuition assistance that enables a diverse group of low-income children to attend Catholic schools.
- Help children and families break the cycle of poverty and disadvantage by supporting access to quality Catholic education in the two counties, Alameda, and Contra Costa, that comprise the Diocese of Oakland.
